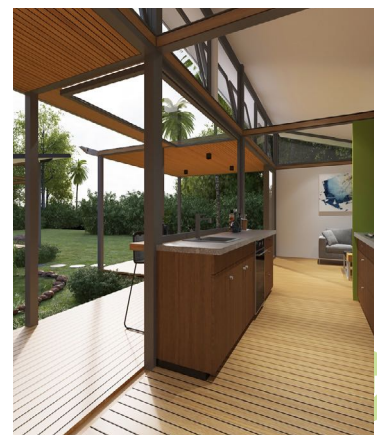

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A cost effective solution for a mining community

The brief was to deliver a product that was cost effective in its design - inherently by the smaller nature of the dwellings, and also by close consideration of construction cost efficiency, repetition of layouts and design details, and the life cycle costs of materials specified. The dwellings were to be designed for occupation by small families or couples without children, with two bedrooms suitable for share households.
